Perhaps It Is Just a Thought

Our annual church conference was held on January 21st after the worship service with Rev. Nymphas Edwards, the district superintendent, San Jose District, presiding over the conference. I want to thank all who attended the conference and also our church leadership for helping get things ready assuring the conference went well. With the addition of new church officers, we are ready, as an organization, to launch another year of ministry. I also would like to outline some of the things that we are expected to accomplish this year.

First of all, there will be leadership training. Leadership of our church consists of different officers, committee members, and the pastor. Among other things, as an organization, our church life depends on how effectively the leadership fulfills various tasks assigned. This is something obvious. But we know there are sometimes gaps between expectations and outcome. To remove such gaps we will place special emphasis on leadership training. For this, we will use *Local Church Guidelines*, a publication from the General Board of Discipleship, and *the Book of Discipline*. Both are primary materials for leadership training in the United Methodist Church and there will be some minimum reading required. We will also attend the San Jose district training event scheduled for February 25 at Pacific Grove UMC, Pacific Grove. Please mark this date.

Concurrently taking place with the leadership training will be our own church planning. In addition to planning what we have been doing routinely, we will set specific goals for this year and beyond and we will plan how to realize them. Special attention will be given to the idea of starting an ethnic language ministry that would target the Filipino American population in the area. Also, we will explore various community outreach opportunities and at the same time we will look into the possibilities of cooperative work with other churches and non-profit organizations in the area—in fact, there are three other congregations that already use our facilities and two non-profit community service organizations renting our facilities. Also, to be kept in consideration as we plan, this year is the 50th anniversary of our church. Bishop Shamana will be able to attend if we plan the anniversary celebration for July 14.

As I am writing this, I find myself at the half-way point of my first year at Sunnyhills. My view of Sunnyhills has not changed: A group of good people with great potentials. As long as we develop a common vision as a community of faith and a sensible plan for the vision, there may well be a 100th anniversary celebration in the future. It is really foreign to me even to think in this kind of a time frame, and by all likelihood I will not be around by then. But why can't I, even though it may be just a thought? Come to think of it, our children and grandchildren who are among us now may very well be there.


With a Song in Your Heart, and a Tap of your Toe...
