Dear Members and Friends,

I received an email last week from Bo Wen, a youth member at Park Presidio UMC where I used to serve before I was appointed to Sunnyhills. The email message was sent to tell me now that he is going to college starting this fall, his mother is going to China. Before she leaves for China they want to have a dinner with me. I replied that I would love to come. And then I found his phone number in my cell phone directory. I called him and "Pastor Lee" was the first thing he said in reply. He explained that his mother wanted to thank me before she would return. I said I have not done anything for them. Then he said I took them in when they first came to the United States four years ago. Come to think of it, I think I did try to help them; I completely forgot about it, because I thought it was insignificant.

I first met him about four years go and I saw him for the last time two years ago when I left Park Presidio UMC. Bo Wen was junior high student; he was learning English. I remember him as a bright teenage boy with a lot of motivation. He was interested in learning guitar. I initiated a guitar class for the church youth, three of them; and the church bought a guitar, which he ended up using. As for his mother, I tried to find her a job. His mother used to teach Marxism and Chinese philosophy at a teacher's college in her home province. But her English was very limited and she did not have much luck finding a job.

Last Sunday evening I drove to San Francisco and had dinner with them. Bow Wen got taller. He got admission to UC Berkeley. He got a UC scholarship and an additional scholarship from Chinese community organization; so financially he is set for his college. He wants to major in business. His mom's English has noticeably improved. She invited me to visit their place in China, Quan Xi province.

I was very proud of Bo Wen and admire him for his accomplishment. And even I envy him a little for the present moment in his life. He is young and has a wide open future, and he has a plan. No doubt, and I also pray, he will make a contribution in society. I felt good that I was a useful part of his life and so was the church. I just did what I had to do as the local pastor when they came to our church. Since Bo Wen is going to UC Berkeley, we will be in close contact; I hope he will continue to maintain his relationship with the church.

I just wanted to share this story, for it gives me a pleasure when I think of Bo Wen.
