Mission and Discipleship

We, the United Methodist Church, are now doing a denomination-wide church revitalization campaign under the slogan of "Re-think Church." The Church leadership decided to launch the campaign hoping that it would reverse the decline of church membership. And the efforts are focused on engaging in mission with creative approaches with strong emphasis on discipleship.

Teachings on mission and discipleship are not something new in the church; they are as old as Christianity itself. Unwavering commitment to mission informed by discipleship transformed a small group of Galileans into an organized religious movement that later became a powerful institution in the Roman world. Therefore, it is necessary to rediscover these teachings, especially when the Church finds itself in need of revitalization.

According to J. H. Arnold, "Discipleship is not a question of our own doing, it is a matter of making room for God so that he can live in us." This makes a lot of sense particularly as it is understood in light of prayer. Prayer is one activity that Jesus himself emphasized and practiced himself. I explained in my previous letter that the very act of praying is an act of petition and it is directed to God. When we pray, we make a conscious choice to invite God into our life. This act constitutes a real relationship with God.

What is actually happening when we pray? For me, until I am prepared to surrender my own will, real prayer does not even begin. I need to let go of all presumptions and put my faith in God, who is compassionate, just, and truthful, without reservation.

This view of prayer reminds me of Peter's story in John. Jesus asks Peter three times whether he loves Jesus. Peter confidently answers Jesus. Then Jesus says, "I tell you the truth, when you were younger you dressed yourself and went where you wanted; but when you are old you will stretch out your hands, and someone else will dress you and lead you where you do not want to go." It seems like Jesus is giving him a warning to Peter so that he needs to make sure that he is prepared to accept the future no matter what.

Then, discipleship begins with prayer and praying is essentially preparing our self for mission by surrendering our self and renewing our determination and commitment to the purpose of mission. Come to think of it, there is so much the Church can do. There is no lack of what the Church should do. So the real question is whether the Church is willing, which returns to the question of discipleship.
