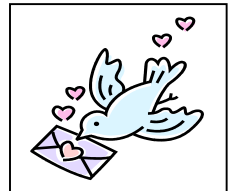

Dear Friends:

I'm writing this sitting at the desk in the Director's Cabin, at Camp Lodestar, in Wilseyville (Gold Country). Out the window are acres and acres of pine, redwood and other native trees.

Just out of site is the amazing meadow. It is brown now, but thanks to late rains, the meadow was green and flowering until just a few weeks ago. This is the week I set aside each year to do longer range worship planning.

A new feature of the Director's Cabin is Internet access. I'm still on the fence as to whether or not I think this is a good thing. I was grateful last night when my daughter was able to send me pictures of a wound that Bailey, my Paint horse has sustained.

Somehow he always manages to get hurt when I'm out of town. The pictures let me see how serious (or in this case, not serious) the wound is. And I've been grateful to be able to easily look up a reference, worship elements, and the like that aren't in the library I brought with me.

But the downside is that I've also gotten involved (via email) with several issues that really could have waited until next week. And I've been able to do some wander shopping that really could have waited... you get the picture. Instant messaging makes finding and responding to distractions on a retreat – way too easy.

You may wonder why I am regaling you with the litany of distractions during my week of retreat. You are hearing about them because each of you has those same temptations and distractions that take you away from quality time. Yours may not be computer or internet based. Maybe yours is one more game of solitaire, one more ball game on TV, or one more episode of whatever your favorite TV program is. Now, don't get me wrong. In and of themselves these are not necessarily bad ways to spend time. But you also need retreat time... Sabbath time as scripture calls it. And time at the computer, on the internet, or playing cards is probably not filling that need.

That is the need to spend some quality time with God: Listening, pondering, questioning, complaining, working out the stuff of our lives and our relationships.

So I urge you to find your own retreat time or Sabbath time. Put aside an hour (or several), and make your time with the Holy Spirit a priority for that time. Our relationship with God only grows when we show up to that relationship.

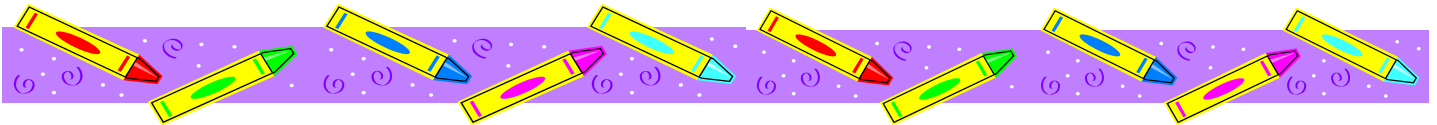
