Dear Friends,

I've just returned from three and a half days of an amazing conference. This interfaith conference, held here in San Jose, was themed "Unity in Diversity". Many of the presentations and worship services celebrated the similarities and and common values among the diverse groups represented. Our differences were not ignored, but also not emphasized over the course of the weekend.

In a particularly moving worship time, we were challenged to release the energy that binds us to rage, obsession fear, guilt and greed, ending the time with comfort and anointing to reclaim the wholeness in which God has created us. I was touched and heartened by the active response of those in attendance.

Another worship time I particularly enjoyed was for those of us who are in "the last third" of our lives women of 55 and older. While I'm not ready to admit I'm in my last third (!), I am 60, and recognize the difference in energy, focus and creativity that age, experience and wisdom bring to our lives. In a particularly moving ritual, we each were given pieces of Solvy, a water soluble fabric. On the fabric, we were invited to write words representative of the things of our lives from which we wish to be freed. I made my claim to let go of the "Could have been"s and "Why not"s that too often lead to unproductive retrospection. Boldly written on Solvy, we added ours to a bowl of water on the altar. In the water, these unhelpful emotions and reactions were melted, calling on the healing presence of the Divine to rinse these same things from our lives. Eventually, the bowl was poured at the base of a tree: nature will transform the water into the purity necessary for the tree's life - and our own.

While many of you were privileged to be at Sunnyhills in worship on Sunday morning, with Daislyn Pease leading worship and preaching, I found myself discussing Elijah and Elisha and God as the still, small voice of 1 Kings 19. I also had the opportunity to share new learning from the Claremont School of Theology class I'm taking, "Prayer from a Process Theology Perspective." In a far-from-complete nutshell, process theology posits that we are in continual relationship with God, who at each moment/nano-second presents us with the best possible alternatives for our futures and the well-being of creation. We, in our part of that relationship, are the "energy" with which God works in the universe. I was thrilled to find that my own understanding of process theology and philosophy resonated with folks from many different faith traditions.

All in all, the sharing, comparing, contrasting of our faith stories, and amazing fellowship was uplifting and nourishing. I'm tired, but amazingly refreshed. I spent quality time with a couple of our own congregation members who are finding helpful and nurturing ways to live out their faith - that's always a good time for me!

I feel obliged to tell you the interfaith conference was a gathering of various non-Christian religious groups from across the country. PantheaCon is an annual gathering of mostly Pagan, but also Hindu, Buddhist, Jews an at least a couple of Christians.

Lent starts this week. I challenge each of you to find an appropriate practice for the next 40 days (not including Sundays), to assist you in articulating and giving hands and feet to the faith to which you are called.

Pysanky Egg Decorating Palm Sunday, April 1, 2012

Eggs are symbols of spring and Easter, symbols of bringing new life, fertility, resurrection. In the Ukraine, the practice of using wax-resist egg dying to decorate eggs with symbols of the season is generations old. These eggs, delicately decorated, become family heirlooms, displayed for many years.

On Sunday, April 1, after the Potluck, I'll have everything you need to create your own Pysanky eggs: stylus' to apply the wax, dyes of many colors, suggestions for traditional and not-so-traditional designs. Plan on spending stretching your creative juices in the spirit of the season.

At Operation Care and Comfort Troop Packing this month I met and had a conversation with a young man, Kyle, back on a months leave from Afghanistan. He said what excitement it was to have a box of goodies waiting for them after days or weeks out on their



mission. When I asked him for a couple of suggestions his first one was beef jerky and then powdered, sweetened drink mixes to put in their bottles of water. They cannot drink the water there. Things I saw being packed were small packages of snacks, all kinds of bars, instant oatmeal, popcorn, cup of noodles, instant coffee, coffee mate tea bags, hot chocolate, cider mix, sugar, sweetener, batteries, pens, pencils, greeting cards (written to them and blank ones), stationary, comic books, funny papers(from Sunday Paper), baby wipes, hotel/travel sized personal, hygiene and toiletries and socks to name a few. *Jo Roll*


