Dear friends,

Annual conference is over for another year. This week, all the pastors and clergy in new appointments meet their new congregations **AND** begin the dance that brings them together as a team. I thank God and the bishop (and his cabinet) that I am remaining at Sunnyhills!

Annual Conference did have some exciting points. A proposal to change the Apportionment calculation was tabled for the year, to allow for further study and better understand the unintended consequences of the new formula. Our old calculation is based on how much we spend in several areas of ministry and salary. Under the old formula, our apportionments will be about \$5,000 per year. The new formula calculates apportionments as a straight 10% of income. Easy to calculate, and easy to understand, but in the new formula, the smaller churches of the conference bear a disproportionate amount of the total. Our own apportionments would be on target to go up by about \$7,000 per year, to about \$12,000 per year. I expect that the new formula will be back, but we'll have had some time to figure out how to pay our fair share.

The other big piece of surprising legislation occurred on Saturday after I'd returned home.

John Oda, one of our San Francisco pastors, wrote it this way in his Facebook post: "Because the present structure and policies of the UMC deny full participation to LGBT sisters and brothers, the Cal-Neva Annual Conference voted today to establish a study committee to seek alternative ways of being a Wesleyan Church, such as the establishment of regional Central Conferences [with contextual portions of the book of discipline], or becoming an autonomous church. This could get interesting!"

I'll second John's comment-this could get interesting!

Daislyn will bring you more information on the workings of the annual conference when she leads worship on July 15. If you have questions, don't hesitate to contact Daislyn or me.

Travel is on many of our calendars this summer. Please drop me a note if you are out of town for a few weeks. We'll keep you in prayer while you are gone, and will know why you aren't with us on Sunday mornings!
