Dear Friends,

This month I've started on a new adventure, the Academy for Spiritual Formation. The Academy is an Upper Room ministry (a division of the United Methodist Church). We will meet together at Mercy Center in Burlingame once a quarter for the next two years. If the first week is predictive, it will be a challenging, deepening, humbling and enlightening experience. My hope for the Academy experience is to be able to better articulate my experience and vision of God in the world and within ourselves, so to be a better guide for Sunnyhills. So far, that hope seems attainable.

As you probably know, I've taken up another adventure in the last year: I'm studying martial arts at Ascension Martial Arts in San Jose. I've advanced to Green Belt in Kung Fu, Second Level in T'ai Chi, and have just begun to advance in Classical PaQua.

I'm not telling you this to brag about my newly found physical fitness (though I recommend it highly!), nor the Academy's reading requirement, (think graduate school.) I'm sharing this because although I really don't like change, there aren't a lot of healthy alternatives. In general, if we aren't moving with change, we stagnate.

Unfortunately, at Sunnyhills we're stagnating. We are doing a fine job keeping the buildings in operational shape – though we're going to have to step up to roofs pretty soon. Our budget is sound, and thanks to your giving and a solid group of organizations who use our facilities, we're able to keep up with expenses.

But I fear for our spiritual health. Worship attendance is poor. Almost all the visitors we've had in the last few years find us on the internet, or because they are in the neighborhood. Only one of our long-term visitors-now-constituents has been invited by anyone in our community. I wonder what that says about us, that visitors who "happen upon us" tend to stay for awhile, but for whatever reason we don't think enough of our selves to invite others.

I ask you to think and pray about what change needs to look like at Sunnyhills. Is it time to band with other congregations so that the time spent on upkeep of our property is not the major "ministry" of our people? Is there another direction that God is nudging you - no matter how far outside the way we've always done things? Is it time for...??

Think and pray on these things – and tell me about your thoughts.


