

Dear Friends.

I've just returned from my annual foray to the mountains for our Conference Kids camps: Super camp for middle schoolers, and Super Kid Camp for elementary children. This year we served 67 campers with 13 cabin counselors and 9 in the support team. As usual, I spent my time in arts and crafts, logistics, campfires and music. Our theme, "Get Real" used stories of Jesus as teacher, healer, friend, and savior. Worship, music and even our craft projects reflected the theme. On our last day, when asked what they learned this week that they want to share at home, the most frequent answer was "God loves us!"

This was especially brought home to me with a special request for our Saturday morning worship. That service is the last thing we do as a group, and always includes communion. This year, it also included a brief "God parenting" liturgy. One of our long time counselors lost his Mom 5 years ago, and his family has not recovered. Over that time, one of our support staff members has been there for him, mentoring, guiding and lifting him up during difficult times. And this year, they decided to make an official statement of this relationship, deciding "Godmother" and "Godson" were the appropriate names, even though the relationship is most often used for newborns. I was honored to be part of this, along with our staff members daughter, and our counselor's good friend. God loves us, and this was one more tangible way to show it.

On a completely different note, we've had some ongoing and long term internet problems at the church office. If you've sent something via email and haven't gotten a response, call the office. It may have been overlooked in the on-again off-again Internet saga.

And finally, Sunday, August 17 is Pride Silicon Valley. Sunnyhills is sharing a booth with several other United Methodist Churches, and many of us will be there all day. Call the church office, or sign up in the Sanctuary if you'd like to be a part of this festival.
