

Dear Friends,

I just got a peek at Scott's cover for this month's Beacon. It is so exactly right for this time in our history!

As you probably have heard, the Supreme Court's decision of last week confirms that states do not have the right to make same-sex marriage illegal. Coming the weekend before many Gay Pride celebrations across the country, the timing is especially joyful.

Bishop Warner Brown's letter to the Conference explains:

This Supreme Court decision calls attention to the difference between the laws of the United States, and the policy of our church. The law does not require anyone to violate their conscience of what God has called them to do, or their theological understanding. But, if we seek to be an inclusive church that serves all of our parishioners, and all of our neighbors, we will have to consider how we treat all people equally. The heart of our call to ministry is to be pastor to the people of the congregation, and the community, we serve. May we continue to be a people of prayer, and hope, as we work towards a day of equality and inclusion for all people created in the image of God.

As most of you already know, I view my ministry own ministry to be inclusive of all individuals, officiating in marriages requested by loving couples. While the "rules" of the United Methodist church still lag behind the laws of our country and many Christian's understanding of God's call, we pray that our General Conference, held next May in Portland, Oregon, will find collective wisdom to see our way through this.

In rejoicing over this decision, we must also continue to hold in prayer our brothers and sisters in Charleston, South Carolina. The community there has been an amazing example of living their faith, speaking words of forgiveness even while held in the bonds of grief.

I'll be out of town much of July, attending a conference in Albuquerque sponsored by Richard Rohr, Jesuit and author; our conference youth camp at Camp Lodestar, and the Mexico Mission. Despite being away, I'll have my cell phone with me, and will return calls as soon as possible. If you have a Pastoral Care need, call me: 408-505-6462. Finally, Vai Heimoana will be preaching at Sunnyhills while I am gone. We'll lead worship together on July 5, and he'll have the pulpit the rest of the month. Please come and support this wonderful preacher-in-training!
