Dear Friends,

This week my head is completely full of Miracle Sunday. As you know, October 4 is miracle Sunday. All the congregations, not for profits and community groups that meet on our campus are invited to join us for worship that morning. Rev. Staci Current, our new District Superintendent is preaching, Sylvia, Marjorie and Mike Halloran are providing special music, and the service will be co-led by all the pastors of Sunnyhills. Potluck luncheon follows. It is a big celebration of who we are, and also an opportunity to fund our last roof. We need \$22,000 to make it a reality. With this winters forecast (and badly needed rains) we need to get this roof done! I hope you will be there! Worship starts at 10:00. If you are able-bodied, please find a parking place on the street to leave our lots for less-frequent attendees and those who cannot walk that far.

Choir begins this week, and though we're not singing on Miracle Sunday, I expect the choir to be back to usual Sunday anthems in October. If you've ever had a hankering to sing, now is the time to join us! Check the weekly schedule to confirm which Thursday nights we are meeting (in the Sanctuary at 6:30).

And finally, please keep our Sunnyhills community in prayer. Our UMC attendance has fallen again, as has our giving. Although our community congregations and services that meet at Sunnyhills provide enough funding to keep our lights, power, and water on, we teeter on the edge of being forced to make some hard decisions on the future of our congregation. This is Scott Zeise's last edition of the Beacon. His work in the office has been invaluable, but we simply cannot afford an administrative assistant at this time.

Our situation is much more than just finance: As an aging congregation, the spirit may be willing, but the bodies may not have "willing" time or energy to give to rebuilding our community as we have done several times in the past. If we can no longer sustain ministry in its current incarnation, what do we want to do with our spiritual lives? Join with another congregation? Federate with one of our Sunnyhills tenant communities?

I am sure that you want to make the decisions about our future, not leaving them up to the Conference or District Superintendent. I don't want to leave you with the impression that these decisions will be made in the next 2-3 months, but I believe they must be addressed in the next 6-8 months. Pray, talk, think, respond to me, Bob Roll as Ad Council chair, or Guy Haas as Staff-parish Chair.
