We observe **World Communion Sunday** alongside members of many denominations the first Sunday in October each year.

World Communion Sunday is a reminder that we are a part of the Body of Christ that is global. Our connection with other believers goes beyond our local churches, our conferences and jurisdictions, and even beyond our denomination. When we take Holy Communion, we are also taking it in communion with the faithful followers of Christ throughout the world.

As United Methodists, we observe World Communion Sunday with this reminder of the global church as well as with a call to give in a way that makes a global impact. World Communion Sunday is one of our denomination-wide special offerings. Today's offering goes toward World Communion Scholars, providing scholarships to individuals connected with global ministries, equipping them to better serve the church both in international settings and national settings in communities of color. Those receiving these scholarships to seminaries and universities continue in ministry to the church and community upon graduating for at least five years.

Many Gifts, One Spirit

Laity Sunday *Special Worship Service* *Sunday October 21st*

*“Bless the Lord, O my soul.
O Lord my God, you are
very great. You are clothed
with honor and majesty.” —
Psalm 104:1, NRSV*

Writing to the church at Corinth, the apostle Paul reminded them that each person is gifted—but no two people are exactly alike. “Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit; and there are varieties of services, but the same Lord; and there are varieties of activities, but it is the same God who activates all of them in everyone.” (1 Corinthians 12:4-6, NRSV)

Troubled by the church’s failure to reach the vast majority of the people, John Wesley abandoned conventional ministry modes and experimented with innovative approaches. The result? Spiritual revival broke out in England and beyond.

As the early Methodist movement flourished, Wesley invited laity, both men and women, to oversee classes (small groups) and preach in society meetings (large groups). When he released the energies of the laity, the ministry multiplied even faster.

Prayer: Loving God, whether we are laity or clergy, you bless each of us with unique gifts and graces. Show us ways to share our talents to further your work. Amen.
